## P1030 Health Claims - Formulated Supplementary Sports Foods & Electrolyte Drinks

Food Standards Australia and New Zealand (FSANZ) has commenced a health claims consultation to permit formulated supplementary sports foods (FSSFs) to carry health claims about physical performance and sport-related beneficial physiological effects (beyond the current limited permissions) and to enable electrolyte drinks to make self-substantiated health claims.
